Recent Developments:

- 1. Martin has repaired the vandalised drain on the workshop. The irrigation pipe has been patched up but might need further work.
- 2. Lancaster Music Festival The Triangle was used as a venue for Folk musicians during the festival. Dave received a letter of support for the event from a local resident. Mike took photos of the event and these can be seen on our website gallery.
- 3. People have been lighting barbecues on the buttress and by the raised beds.

Main Agenda:

- 1. Dave successfully applied to Lancaster University Wind Turbine Community fund for a grant of £840 to replace the bench on the Triangle. The brown and black version was our preferred option. Dave to ask for an updated quote and get the bench on order for delivery in approx 3 months.
- 2. The wooden mushrooms on the Triangle have decayed. We will look at options for replacing them.
- 3. We are considering having another fair next year. Possibly around May. We could do with some younger volunteers to join us.

- 4. LESS Closing Loops Project are looking for more potential community composting sites for their composting project after their initial sites are established. There will be further discussions with them about using the Triangle as one of their sites.
- 5. We had previously been approached about using the Triangle for an art exhibition but we have had no further contact about this.
