 The base map, on which this information is recorded, is the 1910 Ordnance Survey map of the area (eg Aldcliffe Hall is on the map but was demolished in 1960).  
 Using the 1910 map field numbers, boundaries and acreages have been amended by consulting OS maps for 1931 and 1946 along with three maps copied from Adrian Gifford's collection.

- Green Path
- G - Gates
- CM - Concrete Manhole, which is still there
- CT - Concrete Trough, the foundations of which are still there
- T - Trough, possibly still be there.
- H -- - Hedge, two sections laid in the 1960s
- HM - Hay Meadow fenced off from pasture
- PF - Playing Field, within an area of meadow
- MH - Manhole, the remnants of this may be still there.
- stone drain starting at the CT and proceeding north, then west to the C M, then into field 107 and then south
